

Awana FAQs



What is Awana?

Awana is a nondenominational children's ministry committed to reaching boys and girls with the Gospel of Jesus Christ while training them to serve Him. Awana Clubs are a place where children can play games, memorize Bible verses and learn about missions and Bible lessons throughout the school year.

What ages can come to Awana?

Awana Clubs are for those who turned two before Sept. 1, 2015 through those currently in 5th grade.

Puggles – all who have turned two before Sept. 1, 2015

Cubbies – those currently in 3k and 4k classes

Sparks – those currently in 5k, 1st and 2nd grades

T & T – those currently in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades

When is Awana?

Awana meets every Wednesday nights from 6 pm – 7:45 pm.

What are the costs of Awana?

Awana's fees are \$15 which cover the costs of their uniform. The church will provide their entrance and handbooks. You can pay at the church or pay online at csrachurch.org. click on the give tab, then click on secure give and follow the prompts to pay.

Does your family have to be a member of FBC to attend Awana?

Your family does not have to be attending FBC in order to come to Awana. We welcome anyone who wants to learn more about Jesus and have fun.

Do we have to pre-register and how do I register?

We prefer that you register which allows us to better prepare but all are welcome to come at any time as we having a rolling registration during the year. You can pre-register by going online at csrachurch.org/children and click on Awana and print a registration form or you can pick up a form at the church.

What does my child bring or wear to Awana?

Clubbers should wear their uniform or vest. Each clubber needs to bring their entrance book, or their Awana handbook (after the entrance booklet is completed), their Bible and we love for clubbers to bring friends.

What is the parent expected to do at home with their child for Awana?

Review the materials sent home with your child. The handbooks require some amount of "at home" work for the children to complete their handbooks during the Awana year. Most of the handbooks come with CDs which assist learning the material.
