**\*Medications:** If your child takes daily medication, please complete the attached form. Pack the completed Medication Dispensing Form and place with medications/scripts in a Ziploc bag. Students will give this to their Small Group Leader at the host home. The form is necessary and kept with meds at all times. Students who carry an inhaler or Epi-Pen for preventive purposes DO need to turn in a completed Medication Dispensing Form.

**First Aid kits are on premises and available throughout the weekend should any student need pain medication or attention to a minor injury/cut. Parent will be contacted as necessary.**
